












SOURCES OF INSURANCE

Health			 May cover doctors' visits, hospital bills, vision care, dental care, etc. If dollars are limited, health insurance is extremely important
Disability	Payment to replace earnings during times when workers cannot work due to illness or injury	individual, and or government	
Long-term care	payment for externed nursing care when a person cannot live indepently	Individual	
Property	paymenr to insurace person if his property is damaged or destroyed by an accident	Individual
